The Canadian Wildlife Federation is seeking a horticultural student or experienced gardener to maintain our demonstration garden in Kanata. We are a national non-governmental conservation organization and use the garden to demonstrate wildlife-friendly gardening with a focus on native plants. The garden includes several perennial and shrub beds with treed areas scattered throughout.

Primary responsibilities include the maintenance of existing plants and beds (planting, transplanting and subsequent watering; weeding; mulching; and monitoring/addressing pest damage) as well as some enhancement projects. There may be opportunity to assist with research, writing and/or uploading data to our www.wildaboutgardening.org website.

The position would start the beginning of May (or earlier) for approximately 16 – 18 weeks. We seek a responsible individual with gardening experience and an interest in native plants and wildlife.
