(A) The riverbanks.

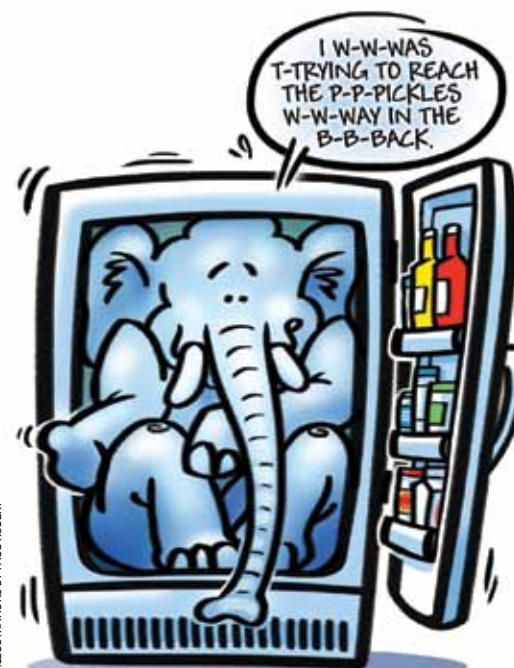
(Q) What is the wettest animal?
