Main Purpose

The Canadian Wildlife Federation is seeking a horticultural student or experienced gardener to maintain our demonstration garden in Kanata. We are a national non-governmental conservation organization and use the garden to demonstrate wildlife-friendly gardening with a focus on native plants. The garden includes several perennial and shrub beds with treed areas scattered throughout.

Primary responsibilities include the maintenance of existing plants and beds (planting, transplanting and subsequent watering; weeding; mulching; and monitoring/addressing pest damage) as well as some enhancement projects. Key Responsibilities

- Create and build upon existing lists of relevant groups to contact such as horticultural societies, field naturalist clubs, botanical gardens, community garden associations etc.
- Contact these groups and highlight our relevant programs and resources that could be of assistance to them as well as look for opportunities for partnering and cross promotion.
- Follow up with any groups who wish to have an outdoor space certified through CWF's habitat certification program.
