

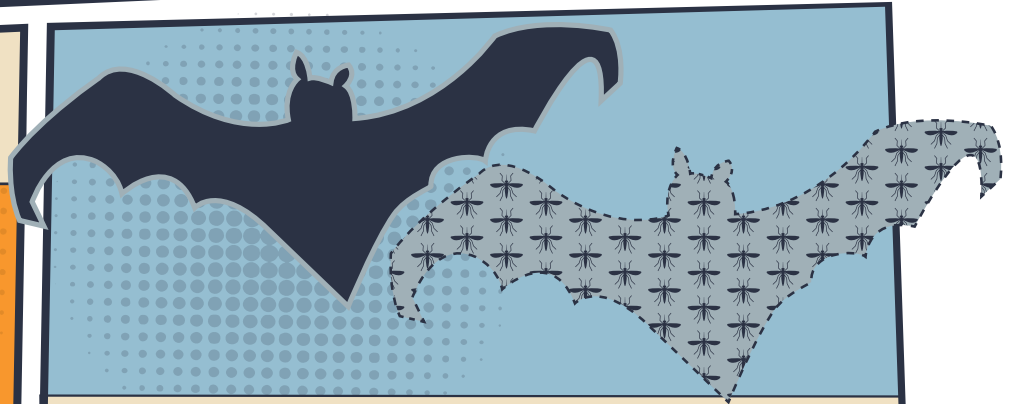
# Pulling for **BATS**

INVASIVE PLANTS OUT-COMPETE NATIVE PLANTS, RESULTING IN FEWER NATIVE PLANTS.



NATIVE PLANTS SUPPORT DIVERSE INSECT POPULATIONS BY PROVIDING FOOD FOR ADULTS AND LARVAE. INSECTS WILL FEED ON NECTAR, POLLEN OR LEAVES AND SOME WILL FORAGE ON ONLY ONE SPECIES OF NATIVE PLANT.

MORE NATIVE PLANTS = MORE BENEFICIAL INSECTS



BATS CAN EAT THE EQUIVALENT OF THEIR WEIGHT IN INSECTS EACH NIGHT.



PULLING INVASIVE PLANTS REDUCES THE COMPETITION, THUS SUPPORTING NATIVE PLANTS, INSECTS, AND THEREFORE BATS.
