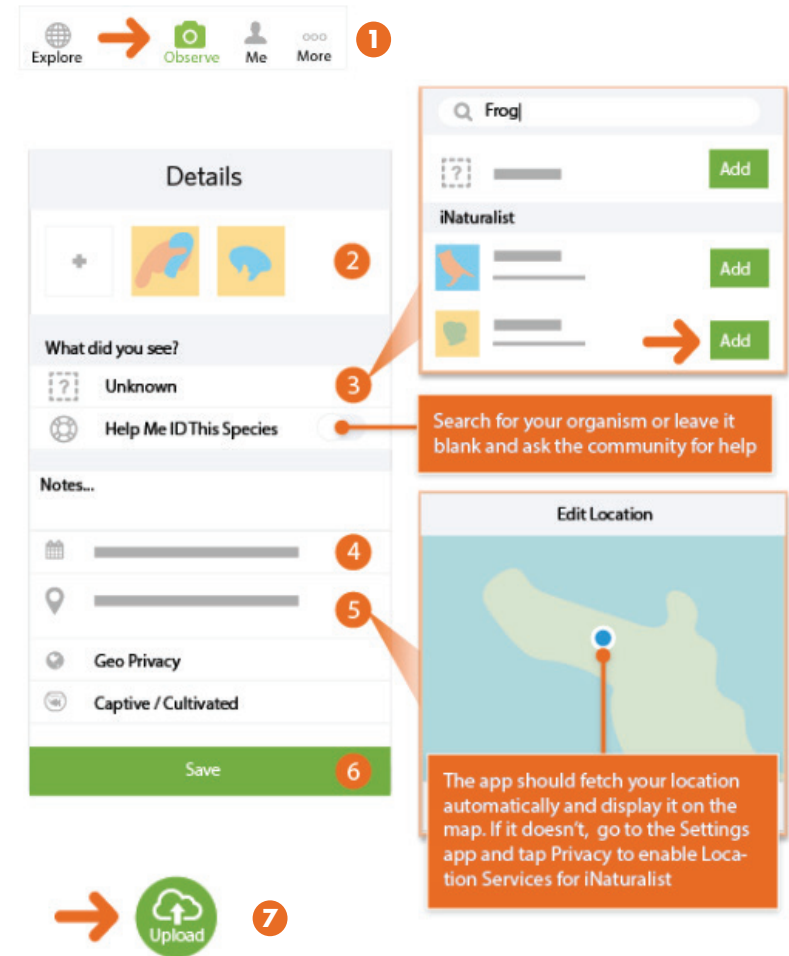




## How to Make an Observation with your iPhone

- 1 Tap **observe**
- 2 Add one or more photos as **evidence**
- 3 Enter **what** you saw or leave this blank
- 4 **When** you saw it should be added automatically
- 5 **Where** you saw it should be added automatically, if not check Privacy in the Settings app
- 6 **Save** your observation
- 7 **Upload** to share with the community. This should happen automatically, if not tap the button. You can turn off autoupload from the app settings from the Me tab.



## How to Make an Observation With Your Android Device

- 1 Tap **observe**
- 2 Add one or more photos as **evidence**
- 3 Enter **what** you saw or leave this blank
- 4 **When** you saw it should be added automatically
- 5 **Where** you saw it should be added automatically, if not check Privacy in the Settings app
- 6 **Save** your observation
- 7 **Upload** to share with the community. This should happen automatically, if not tap the button. You can turn off autoupload from the app settings from the Me tab.





## How to Make an Observation from the Web

- 1 Log in to your account at iNaturalist.ca and click **Add** from the top right dropdown list.
- 2 **Drag and drop** photos from a folder on your computer or click **Choose photos**
- 3 Enter what you saw or leave this blank
- 4 **When** you saw it should be added automatically, if not use the calendar to enter a date
- 5 **Where** you saw it will be added automatically if you have a gps enabled camera or if using a smartphone with the GPS turned on. Otherwise click on the Location field and select a spot on the map
- 6 You can add common dates or locations to several observations at a time by Selecting all or Ctrl clicking and using the options on the left side of the screen
- 7 **Submit** your observation
