Save the Birds with Window Stickers

In Canada an estimated of 16 million to 42 million birds die each year because of bird collisions. By creating stickers and attaching them to your window, you will prevent birds from colliding into windows and you will brighten your windows with colour too!

What You'll Need:

- 2 tablespoons of white glue
- 2 drops of dish soap
- Food colouring (optional, liquid or gel)
- 2 plastic page protectors
- Cookie cutters
- A spoon
- A small bowl



• Sparkles (Optional)



MIX the glue, dish soap and food colouring in a small bowl with a spoon. Do this for two minutes.



PLACE a cookie cutter on top of a plastic page protector.



PAINT a semi-thick layer of the mixed glue, dish soap and food colouring inside the cookie cutter on the plastic page protector.



LEAVE the cookie cutters on the mixture for 30 minutes to prevent the mixed glue, dish soap and food colouring from spreading and losing its shape.



REMOVE the cookie cutter, add the sparkles (if you'd like!) and let the mixture dry overnight.



PEEL off the stickers once they feel dry and stick them onto a window!



REPEAT the project as many times as you'd like. The more stickers, the safer the window for birds. Just remember to put the window stickers as close together as possible.
