
App Instructions

- 2. Create a **free account** or sign in to an existing account.

3a. **APPLE APP**: Click 'More' in the bottom right corner and click 'Projects'. Click the magnifying glass in the top right corner to search for our project. In the search bar, type "Virtual Land Art BioBlitz 2020" and sleect our project. Click 'Join' under the project title.

3b. **ANDROID APP:** Click the three bars in the top left corner and click '**Projects**'. Search for "Virtual Land Art BioBlitz 2020" and select our project. Click '**Join**' under the project title.
