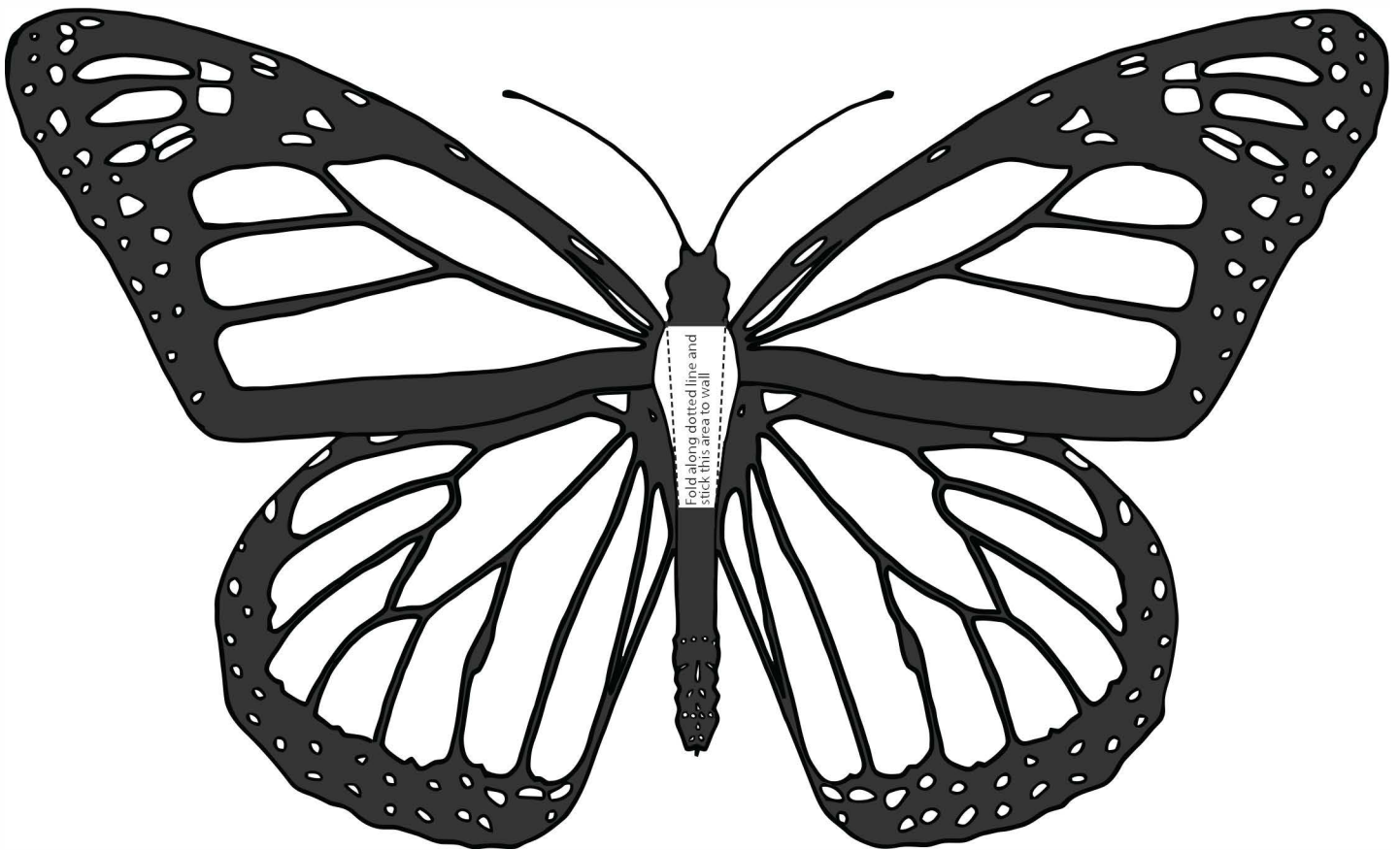


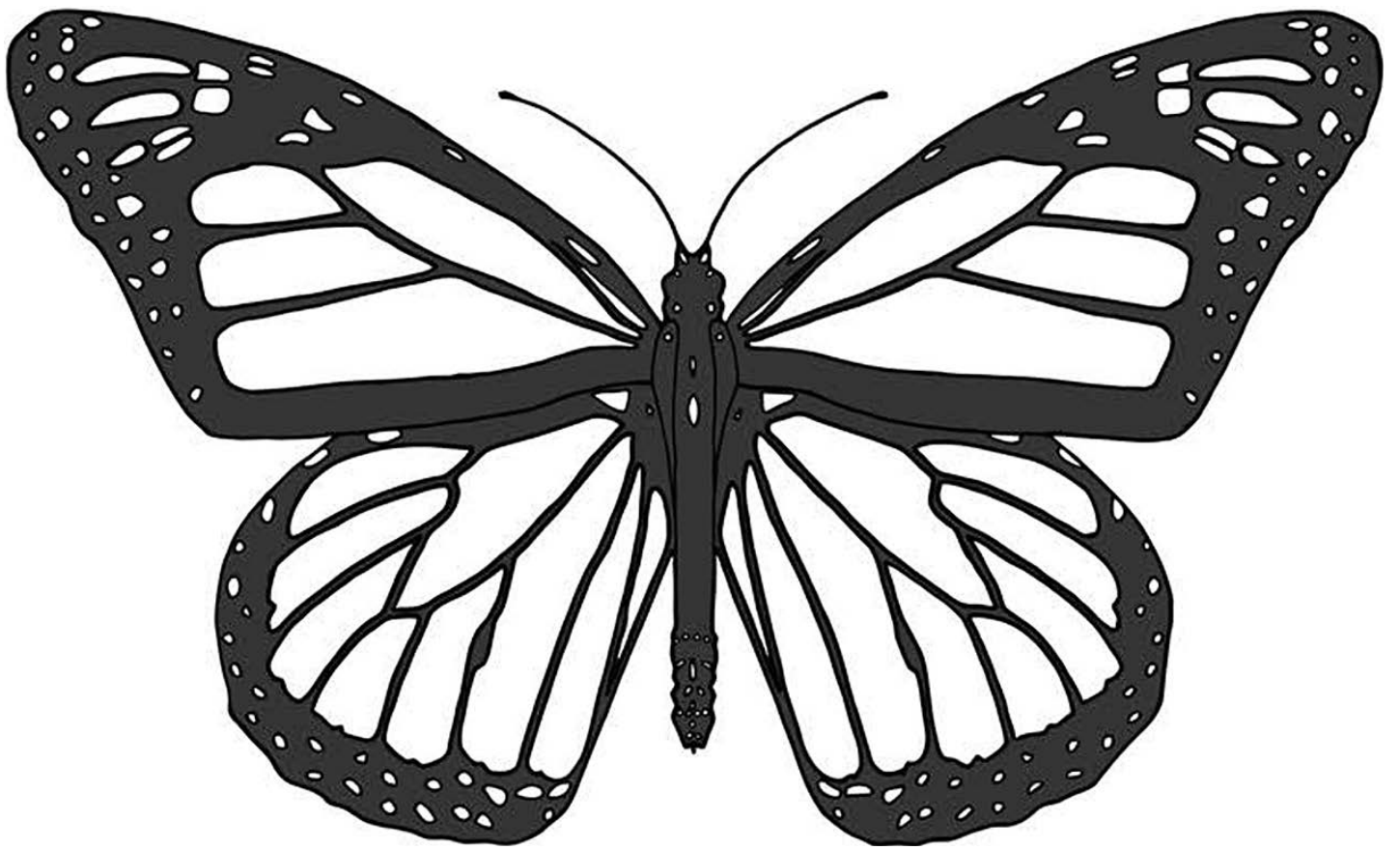
# Activity: Make a Monarch Butterfly

Did you know that a group of Monarchs is called a kaleidoscope? When they gather together overnight in a tree (to roost) during migration, their fluttering wings look like what you see in a kaleidoscope!

Bring this Monarch Butterfly to life with colour! In this activity, you will create a reminder of the Monarch's amazing migration journey each Fall from Canada to Mexico. Butterfly



- Colour both sides of the Monarch. Notice the colour differences on each side.
- Cut out the Monarch and fold it in half.
- Post your coloured cut-out(s) on a wall. They will look like Monarchs do when they roost in trees overnight during migration!
