



What mammal is this?










The grizzly is the second largest North American land carnivore, or meat-eater, and, like the larger polar bear, has a prominent hump over its shoulders formed by the muscles of its massive forelegs. A solitary animal, its home range varies in size but is usally 200 to 600 km² for females and 900 to 1,800 km² for males.


